

Asim Ulke 3NT. Over partner's expected 4D, I bid 4H. If partner bids 5D, I take a bathroom brake.

Bill Holt: Pass. We donot have the ammo to fight this battle at the 4-level if partner could not overcall 2NT. Double buys either -530 or a probable 4d bid which I wongt like. I am not strong enough, nor are my suits good enough to overcall. So the thing to do is apologize & surrender.

Gail Carns: X (double) If I would bid over 2S p p then I bid over 2S p 3S. Also over 4D by partner I bid 4Hexpecting partner to know I have Hs and Cs

Fred Schenker 4C. I don't think x is right. Pard did not have enough to overcall 2N, so I don't think we are I would expect a 4D bid, which I would correct to 4H. In this case, I would expect pard's shape to be 4-3-4 -2 or 4-3-5-1. If pard has a good hand Ernie Retetagos: . Pass!! Are you kidwith Cs, I would expect a raise to 5. We may be missing a H fit, but there are too many bad things that could happen if I start with a double.

Steve Nolan 3NT. It will be obvious to partner from his own holding that this cannot be a natural bid. If I had a singlesuited hand, I would have bid my suit; if I had all three. I would have doubled. Therefore this bid shows a twosuiter. Partner can pass or bid a suit. If he bids, I'll pass 4H, raise 4C to 5 or bid 4H over 4D.

Jane Marshall .4NT. I am asking partner to bid his lowest 3-card suit. If he bids 5D, I will bid 5H. (The opponents have a fit, we have a fit I am short in spades.

Jim Bachelder Pass, partner passed in first seat and passed again. Why do I want to come in now, at unfavorable vulnerability, and look for a place to play at the four level? Also, partner might pass and they'll make it.

PJ Prabu Pass. It may be our hand, but it is not clear that we have a game. Partner may have four spades and hence could be short in my suits. Both my suits being very poor, I\u00e3m not venturing in at the 4-level.

Paul Caplan: Pass. This hand can be a total misfit with the wrong vul. if partner wants to compete a balancing double does not promise 4 hearts. Partner may have a spade stack and wish to defend which maybe the only plus score for n-s. missing a game. If pard can't stand Cs, Trudy Cohn: I bid 3 NT which is obviously for two suits. If partner bids Diamonds, I will bid hearts and my shape should be known at that point

ding? If I can't open one club, I'm certainly not forcing to the 4 level. Partner has spade length, but not enough strength to bid 2 NT.

Stan Ruskin .I pass. I can't think of anything else to do. Something strange is going on and I will wait for partner to clarify. I have what partner thinks I have - plus more distribution. If it our hand somewhere partner will clarify. He Must know that I have 0 or 1 spade Maximum and a lot of hearts and A maximum of 10 points. Let him move.

Marvin Rulin Double. I'm torn between double and pass. I have only 9 HCP but my spade void is huge. Partner passed over west's preempt. East 's bid can be just interference or a moderate point count .Double allows partner to pass if he has spade tricks (very possible) or hopefully show a 4 card heart suit. I don't want to be shut out of the bidding.

Florine Walters Double. All options are open. If partner passes the double, I do have two quick tricks.

. Herb Sachs: Pass Obviously I am missing something here. My partner is vulnerable also and alive with some spade length and probably some diamond length but failed to act over two spades-maybe 4-1-5-3 distribution. A small plus or a small minus in three spades versus what? Perhaps a huge number! I pass.

Eric Ruben: 4H, and since you asked, I will bid 5C also, unless partner doubles 4S. We have a fit somewhere and I don't feel like being pushed around today.

Robert Zimmermann: Pass. North could not take an action over 2S, so anything I bid will propel them to a 4S contract that will likely make.
