BRIDGE BYTES

THE PROBLEM.....AND THE SOLUTION

The field had some trouble with a couple of hands from recent club games. In the 1st hand, all of the West players were in 4 hearts, and I would assume that East opened 1 club at almost all of the tables. North had a normal spade lead. Both clubs and hearts split evenly, but most declarers only made 11 tricks.

S- A 6	S-10 4
H- A K Q 10 8 2	H - 93
D- J 10 5 2	D- A 8 6 4
C- Q	C- A K 10 9 7

Evidently, after winning the lead and pulling trumps, declarers played the Queen of clubs, and went to the Ace of diamonds to make a couple of discards on the clubs. The Jack didn't fall, so there were 2 losers. After drawing trumps, the correct play is to "waste" the Queen of clubs and overtake, pitch a spade on the other top club, and lead the ten of clubs, pitching a diamond as South wins the Jack. The diamond Ace is an entry for 2 more discards.

In the 2nd hand, in a 16 table game, only Bob Flynn and John Doyal bid the laydown slam.

I have shown my suggested bidding sequence. After the opening bid, 2 NT is Jacoby, and 3 clubs shows a singleton. East's jump to 4 spades would be fast arrival, denying slam interest. West should still thinking slam, but it is unwise to use Blackwood with two fast losers in a suit. Cue bid the Ace of clubs, and East should bid 5 diamonds. It is vital to show a control. Some think that the cue bid should just show the Ace of diamonds. Opener's failure to ask for Aces suggests that they have a good hand, but are lacking a control in a suit. There is a good chance that opener has the Queen, or the Ace may be onside. Nothing works all of the time, but the 5 club bid is asking you to bid your cheapest control.

Chris Wang I pass. If partner doubles, I will **pass**. If partner passes, I will pass. If partner bids 3S, I will bid 4D

Trudy Cohn: 4D My bid is 4 diamonds. I am not sure whose hand it is but that will give my partner the information on which to make a decision.

Asim Ulke: PASS I pass. I have a partner

Bernie Fudor: PASS .2 **passes** for me . I might bid if I had a clear cut bid but all bids are too unilateral

Herb Sachs: 4D I'm not sitting for any double. With this holding, I cannot defend.

Jane Marshall: Pass and pull a double by partner to **4D**. I'm not sure what the Os mean in the problem. If the spade O is the King, I would bid 4 diamonds immediately.

Steve Nolan: Pass, then pass again. I have what I promised, but no more. It's partner's decision at this point.

Bill Holt Pass. If partner has an opening hand for his X, he'll do something intelligent over 3H. If he bids 3NT he will like my diamond suit. If he doubles, I will pull to 3NT – defending 3HX with such distribution is a smidgen scary. It's Matchpoints so just one board. And I've well-developed apology skills.

I don't think that's likely). There's too much playing strength in this hand to do any less and not enough defense to sit for the second double.

Ernie Retetagos Pass and Pass. It seems right to pass the first time. The only other bid that I could consider is

Stan Ruskin Pass. I have nothing to add at this time and will wait further developments. It seems that we have forgotten how to pass. If partner doubles or bids 3NT, I will **pass**. If he bids 3S, I will bid 5D. If he bids 4D, I will cue bid 4S. I have no idea what partner's hand is. If I bid over 3H, I will never know.

Gail Carns: Pass this says I can't cooperate with a double so partners double is not cooperative thus I **pass** again.

Fred Schenker: PASS (kinda) It is useful to have agreements on whether double here is penalty or takeout, and whether pass is forcing or not. If double is takeout, that's what I bid, and correct 3S to 5D (because pard passed the opportunity to penalize, pard must have Cs). If double is penalty, I pass. If pard bids 3S I bid 5D (same logic as above), if pard doubles or bids 3N, I pass. Thankfully it is a MP hand.

Paul Caplan 4 diamonds. I am not interested in defending at the 3 level.

Robert Zimmerman Pass then 5 Diamonds. Both of partner's doubles show cards, and my diamonds will play opposite a void if necessary (and I don't think that's likely). There's too much playing strength in this hand to do any less and not enough defense to sit for the second double.

Ernie Retetagos Pass and Pass. It seems right to pass the first time. The only other bid that I could consider is 4 diamonds, and now we can't play 3 NT. I feel less confident about the 2nd pass.

Craig Biddle Pass I assume my diamonds are KQJ10732. I pass, then pull double to 3NT. The advantage of this plan is most clearly seen if partner doesn't double 3H - then I know 5D is our best spot. Note that if partner has doubled 3H on, say, J10xx and scattered stuff, they should know to pull 3NT on this auction; if I had a doubleton heart I would most likely sit for the double.
