## INTERNET POST

Here is the question of the month. Matchpoints, both vul. You, South, hold:

S 2 H A9654 D KQ10 C J754

The bidding is:

SOUTH	WEST	NORTH	EAST
PASS	PASS	1D	PASS
1H	PASS	1S	PASS
?			

**Asim Ulke:** I bid 3D. So far I know that partner has at least 4 spades and at least 4 diamonds. With 3 hearts and extra values partner will bid 3H over 3D. With heart shortness and extra values will bid 3NT. With minimum values partner will pass and 3D should be payable even with a 7 card fit.

**Jane Marshall:** 2C I would bid 2C (4th suit forcing for 1 round, not to game, because I am a passed hand). If my partner rebids 2D, I would raise to 3D. If partner bids 2H, I would bid 4H. If partner rebids 2S, I would bid 4D. HOWEVER, I WOULD NOT HAVE PASSED THE 1ST TIME. This hand meets my requirements for an opening bid. It has 11 hcp, 2 quick tricks, and 9 cards in its two longest suits.

**Warren Oberfield:** I bid 2C. Only because it is mp, does 1N merit mild consideration. 1N is an understatement, and if you bid 1N, you'll probably play there, right or wrong. Your stiff spade, and that 9 of your 10hcp are in either your suit or partner's suit both suggest that the right spot is likely a suit contract, and rebidding 2C provides the best chance to find it. If partner's hand is such that we play in 2N or 3N, better to declare from partner's side to protect what may be a tenuous holding in spades, the opponents' 8 card fit.

**Florine Walters:** 1NT. We may have a better fit in Hearts or Diamonds, but if we do not, we will probably arrive in 2NT, or perhaps 3NT if partner has a maximum 14 count. It's match points and therefore will take the probable sure plus in 1NT.

**Bill Holt:** 1NT. Time to hold my nose and bid 1NT. 2H could easily be right but I might be facing a 4054 or 4144 hand and will try for 7 tricks. The case for 2H is to make tricks with my baby hearts by ruffing partner's Spades

**Steve Nolan:** 2D. Safest and most accurate.

**Mary Paulone Carns:** 2C/1NT It would help if I knew my methods. If 2C is natural, or if it is 4th suit invitational (by a passed hand), I bid that. If 2C is 4th suit forcing to game, then I bid 1NT. Yes, my hand is a little heavy but it has flaws. In all 3 of these scenarios, if partner has more than a rock-bottom minimum, we should get to game in the right strain (he should bid 2H next if holding 3 H).

**Stan Ruskin:** 2C I think almost everyone plays that 2C is asking for 3 card support of H. I can't think of anything else to bid. If partner bids 2H I will bid 3H. If partner bids 2D, I will bid 3D. If partner bids 2NT, I will bid 3NT. If partner bids 3C (he could), I would probably bid 3NT or 4C. If partner bids 2S showing 5S and 6D, I will bid 4D.

**Bruce Keidan:** 2D, The heart suit isn't good enough to rebid on this sequence, and 1NT is not bridge, Or even pinochle.

**Lou Joseph:** 2C Very simple if you play fourth suit forcing for 1 round. Unfortunately, only one of my partners is willing to play that - the rest insist on playing fourth suit forcing to game. Luckily I'm playing this hand with the one who plays forcing for 1 round only, so I can bid 2C. If you insist on my playing fourth suit forcing to game, I'm probably going to bid 2C and then consider passing partner's next call if it is 2D or 2NT or 2H and say I had a card misplaced.

**Herb Sachs:** 2 1/2 diamonds if allowed; no ok a loud two diamonds; partner probably has five or six diamonds along with four spades so 1nt although aggressive is wrong sided? im going with the underbid hoping partner has another bid coming.

**PJ Prabhu:** 2D. Normally I'd have 4-card support for this bid, but here the ruffing value and strong support influence me to make this bid. Second choice is 1 NT.

**Gail Carns** 1NT. atimps I would bid 2NT

**Ernie Retetagos** 2C. I play that 4th suit by a passed hand is a one round force, and think that a suit contract will play better than NT.

**Arlene Port: OK** I decline to answer. You see, I have the list of the best answers and mine wasn't on it. I could fake it and choose the number one answer, but I would rather be dumb than lie. And so I am!!
