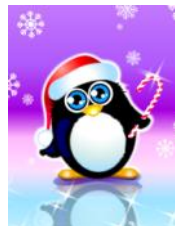

**Florine Walters** 3 spades. I assume partner has one spade, three hearts and 4/5 in the minors. I will pass 3 NT, and if partner bids four of a minor, I will raise to five and play for him to have all his cards in the minors.

**Trudy Cohn:** 3NT I think that I will bid 3NT. Partner doesn't expect me to have anything other than strong spades but I have a surprise in the club suit. If his hand is very distributional, I can support either minor if he chooses to bid one. A vulnerable game is too tempting for me.

**Bill Holt:** Pass. Partner is not assured of holding 4 trumps with the balancing double and I'm not sure of setting it. Never double a part score at teams unless you are certain. We might make 4 minor but since partner did not double 3H I doubt we can make 3NT.

**Jim Bachelder:** Double. LHO didn't bid 3 forcing hearts over 2S so he doesn't have a good hand; he's merely running out of fear to what he hopes is a better spot. And, it appears to be just that, but he's still going down, just not as many. I have 2.5 tricks to contribute on defense and no source of tricks on offense.

**Mary Paulone Carns:** .Double. Not penalty. If pard has something like x, AJxx, KQxx, Kxxx we're much better off defending. If he has x, Kxxx, AKQJx, Kxx (more tricks on offense than on defense) can bid 3NT over the double.

**Stan Ruskin:** I bid 3NT. I don't think I can beat 3H 800 and I can't imagine not being able to make 3NT some way. East is probably 6/2/3/2 or 6/2/2/3 so E/W have some playing tricks even if partner leads a H against 3H doubled. Partner is probably 1/4/4/4 or something like that and West is probably (0)/6/4/3 (3/4). As a result, we should be able to make 3NT some way.

**Marvin Rulin:** pass I don't know how good my partner's double was. It could have been distributional because we know he is short in spades. So who has the balance of power, partner or west? at matchpoints I might double but at imps I'll pass and avoid a big swing.

**Jane Marshall .** I double. My partner may think that I have only spade tricks. I have club cards and partner is sitting behind the heart bidder with heart tricks, diamond cards and club cards. I believe that West has long hearts and, perhaps, a spade void. Since West did not bid hearts until I converted partner's takeout double to a penalty double, he doesn't have a lot of high cards. Partner probably doesn't have a 5 card suit. I think that we can take 5 tricks before West takes 9 tricks.

**Arlene Port:** Double. I know I know the top answer, but I think West is in trouble with the 3H bid and while we may be able to make 3NT, the plus score for setting this little sucker is a surety. Just call me "chicken"!!

HOW EXPERTS VOTED

**Asim Ulke:** .Pass. Partner is not assured of holding 4 trumps with the balancing double and I'm not sure of setting it. Never double a part score at teams unless you are certain. We might make 4 minor but since partner did not double 3H I doubt we can make 3NT.

**Gail Carns:** 3NT anything can be right or wrong but 3NT is the biggest plus when it is right.

**Bob Zimmerman:** 3S. 3NT should be played by North. I can't pass at IMPs, and it's close between 3NT and 3Hx. The upside is +600 vs +500 (or more), but the downside is -100 vs -590. And that scares me. P has to have hearts for the double, though not enough to crack 3H. At worst, I'd expect them to be 6331, so it's likely he can sever communications.

**Auxilliary Expert:**

**Paul Rosenberg:** I would double. If east retreats to 3 spades, I double again for penalty. I can count on my partner North to have at least 4 hearts, so given my hand< I would not be uncomfortable if the double stays in place. If my partner has greats length and bids either minor at the 4 level, I have decent support, although given the vulnerability I would prefer it if east west plays the doubled contract
