## TIMING

Please try and arrive no later than 12:05

Play starts at 12:15

The timeclock is programed with:

2 minutes between rounds to change tables

5-minute break midway

Hand not started with 3 or less minutes on the clock should not be played, call the Director

Play should end by 3:45

## NOISE CONTROL

Players should remain at their table until the round is called

Players having a sit out should leave the playing area to chat

## RESULTS

Players in the North position should show the game results to the players at their table.

The Director will upload results to Pittsburgh.org immediately upon completion of the last hand. These results are available instantly and can be checked on your phones.

Next the Director will upload the results to the ACBL website. These can take up to 20 minutes to post, you will be emailed when they are available.

**Please do not ask Directors about results, interrupting only delays the online results for everyone.**

## Zero Tolerance

The ACBL Zero Tolerance policy states in part:

If a player at the table behaves in an unacceptable manner, the director should be called **immediately**. Annoying behavior, embarrassing remarks, or any other conduct which might interfere with the enjoyment of the game is specifically prohibited by Law 74A. Law 91A gives the director the authority to assess disciplinary penalties.
